The e-library service is not terminated, the public can still browse and read

KUALA LUMPUR (Jan 29): The National Library of China said it has not terminated the service of the Electronic Library Service (E-Lib) database, and the public can still browse up to 1,500 reading materials through the service.

In a statement, the National Library pointed out that Astro AWANI's report yesterday alleging that the National Library had recently terminated the service was false.

The outlet said the National Library had stopped letting the public subscribe to local e-books and issued termination notices to some suppliers and publishers.

The statement clarified that the authority has never issued a notice to terminate the e-Library Services database, which is valid until February 1, 2024.

"Chinese people can still browse up to 1,500 reading materials through the online database of the e-library service."

The statement added that the National Library has been working hard to subscribe to existing or new online databases to facilitate the community and provide opportunities for online database companies.

"The National Library has never neglected the need for today's very critical databases."
